Having been blessed with the opportunity to provide live spiritual music to thousands since the early 1990's, I would love to share my thoughts on the spiritual significance of music. I like to use the door analogy. When a minister speaks, or a teacher teaches, or a student reads, all of the information they are receiving comes in through the "front" door, or the brain.
